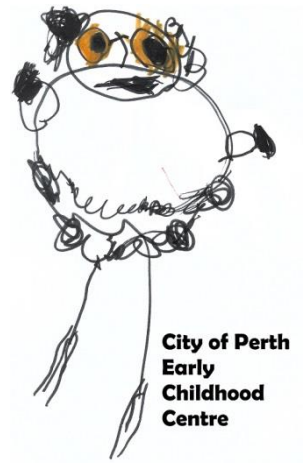


Fortnightly update - Thu 19th Apr 2018
